Any claim must be made within 15 working days of the date of this notice.

Any person making a claim will be required to produce proof of identity and address. Where an agent makes the claim on behalf of their principal, they will need to produce proof of identity and address of themselves and their principal together with proof of authority to act as an agent.

Where the seized property is a motor vehicle with a registration mark, and the person claiming entitlement purports to be the registered keeper, they must produce the registration document.

The authority may be of the opinion that it is necessary to retain the seized property for the duration of an investigation or criminal proceedings.

A seizure authority may sell, destroy or otherwise dispose of seized property where a seizure notice has been published and —

- (a) The claim period had ended and no claim was made;
- (b) A claim was made within the claim period but the seizure authority did not determine that the claimant was entitled to the property.

A copy of this notice has been served on the Chief Constable, and in the case of a vehicle, the registered keeper and any other person identified as entitled to possession, and has been published on the seizure authority's website.

- 2. Proof of address (e.g. two utility bills in the applicant's name, no older than three months).
- 3. Vehicle Registration document for seized property
- 4. Valid insurance
- 5. Written proof of authority to act as Agent IF acting in a representative capacity (e.g. valid power of attorney + items 3-4 above and proof of I.D. and address of Agent)
