CITY OF PRESTON (TENTERFIELD STREET) (OFF STREET PARKING PLACE) ORDER 202*

STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

An area of the former Market Hall and Service Road located off Tenterfield Street is to be redeveloped as a surface car park. The new car park will not only provide an amenity to the local businesses but also provides a facility to remove potential inappropriate parking from surrounding streets, thus relieving or preventing congestion of traffic in the area. The closure and demolition of the former c550 space multi-storey car park at this site has resulted in a general shortfall of parking provision in the area.

As the new car park is to be operated directly by the City Council, it is appropriate that the manner of operation be governed by an Order. This will provide in particular for:

- A Pay and Display Car Park with both a contract and cashless parking option
- Blue Badges to be displayed on appropriate vehicles when parked in designated bays for disabled persons' vehicles
- Contravention of the Order to be enforced by the issue of Penalty Charge Notices
