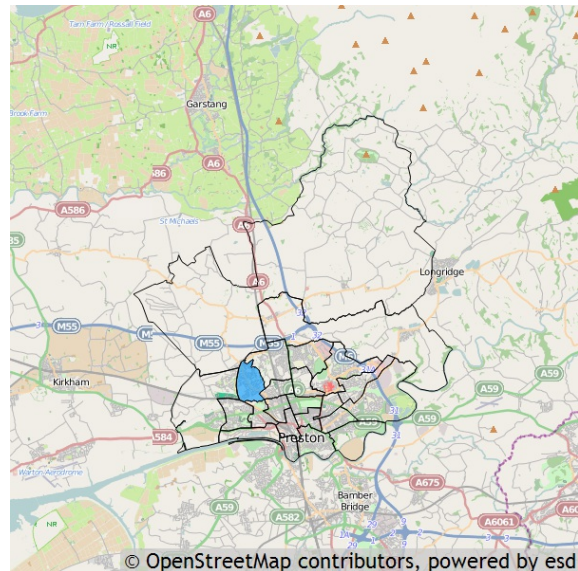


## Basic facts about Ingol

Ingol is one of the 22 wards of Preston. It has an area of 203.62 hectares which represents 1.42% of the total local authority area of Preston.

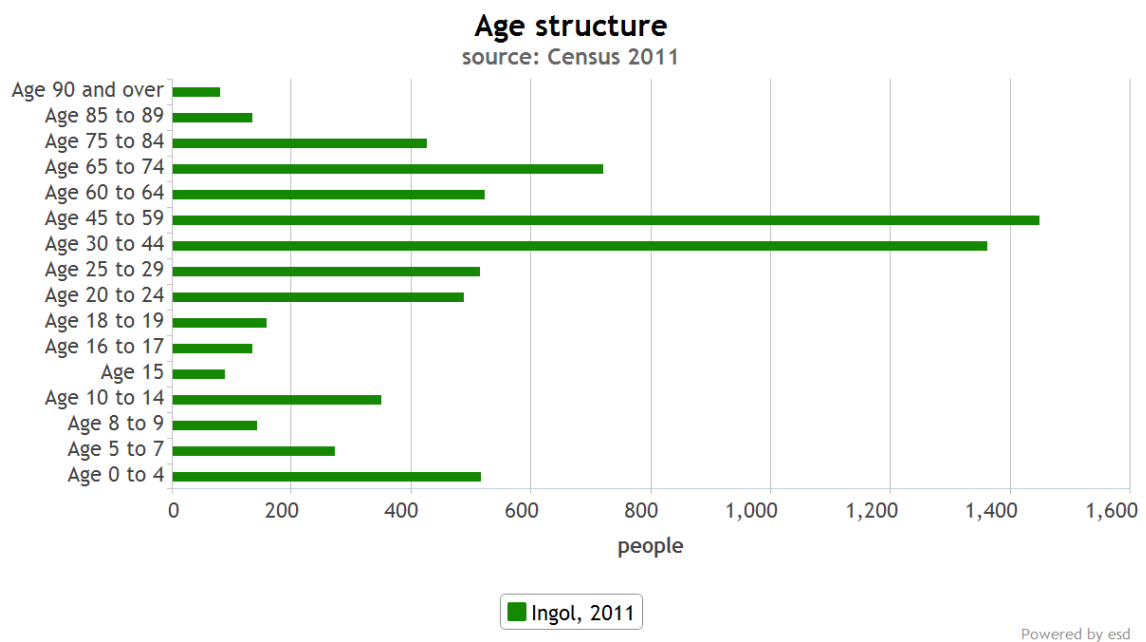


### Residents

Ingol has a resident population of 7,369 which represents 5.26% of the total local authority resident population of 140,202.

### Age

The mean age of the Ingol population is 41 years which is older than the mean age of 37 years for residents in the whole local authority. The predominant age band is Age 45 to 59.

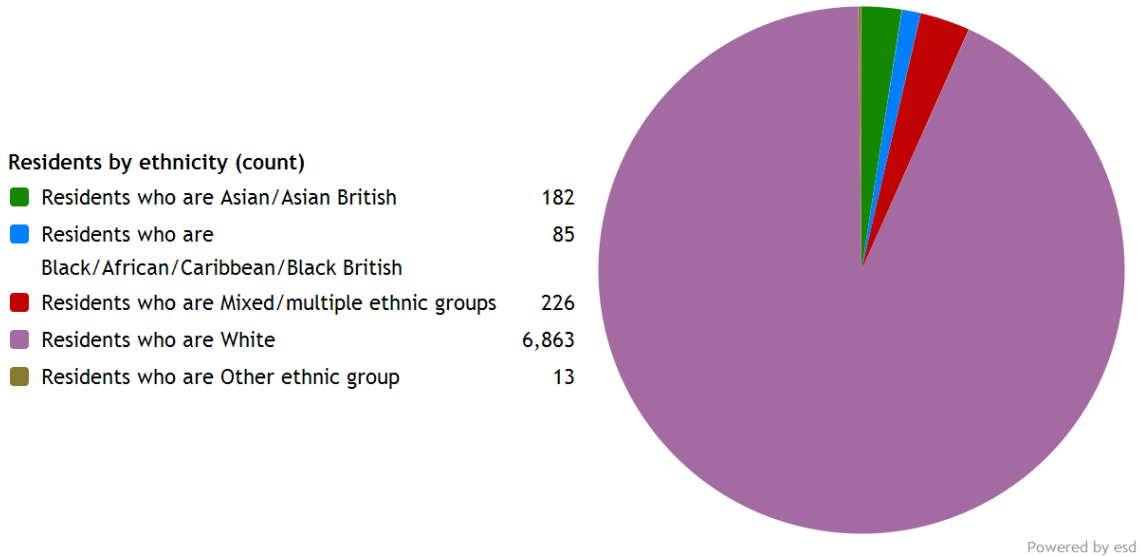


## Ethnicity

The largest ethnic group is *Residents who are White* with 93.1% of the ward's population. That compares with 80.2% for the local authority as a whole, 90.2% for North West and 85.4% for the whole of England.

The second largest ethnic group is *Residents who are Mixed/multiple ethnic groups* with 3.1% of the ward's population. That compares with 2.4% for the local authority as a whole, 1.6% for North West and 2.3% for the whole of England.

The ethnic split of Ingol's residents is shown below.



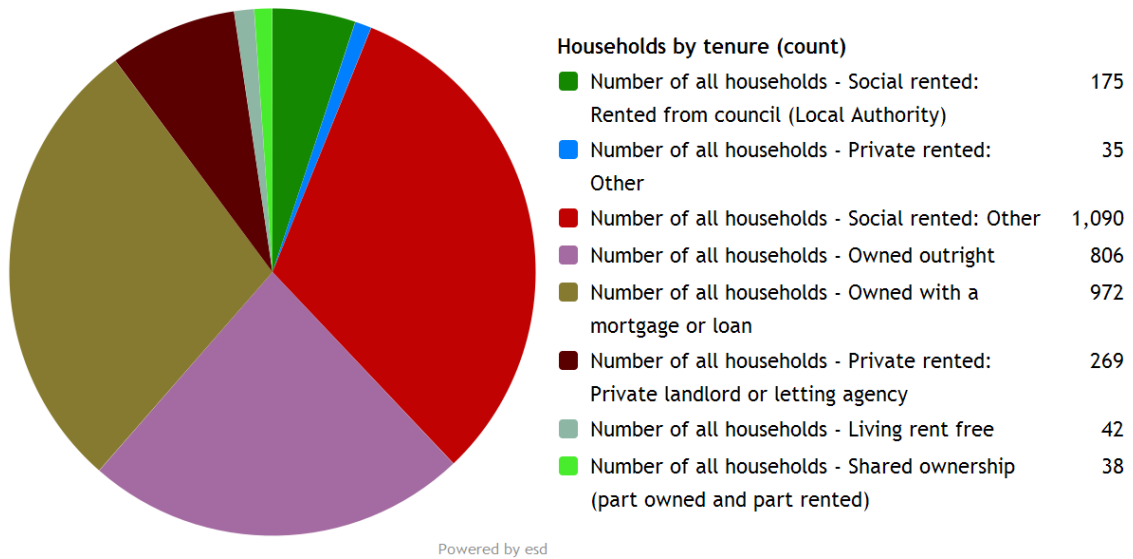
Ingol's resident population is 51.7% female and 48.3% male.

The ward has 417 households with **dependent children aged 0 to 4**. That represents 12.17% of the ward's households.

892 households in the ward have **dependent children of all ages**. That represents 26.03% of the ward's households.

## Households

Ingol has 3,427 households, which represent 5.95% of Preston's 57,567 households. The household split by tenure is shown below.



The largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Social rented: Other* accommodation with 31.8% of the ward's households. That compares with 15.3% for the local authority as a whole, 8.1% for North West and 5.7% for the whole of England.

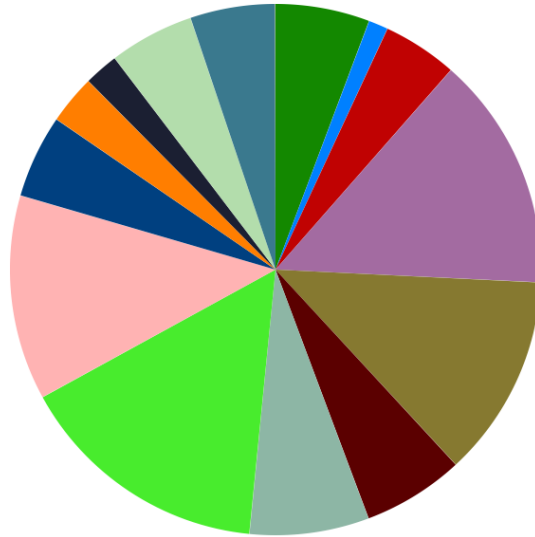
The second largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Owned with a mortgage or loan* accommodation with 28.4% of the ward's households. That compares with 32.2% for the local authority as a whole, 33.2% for North West and 34.5% for the whole of England.

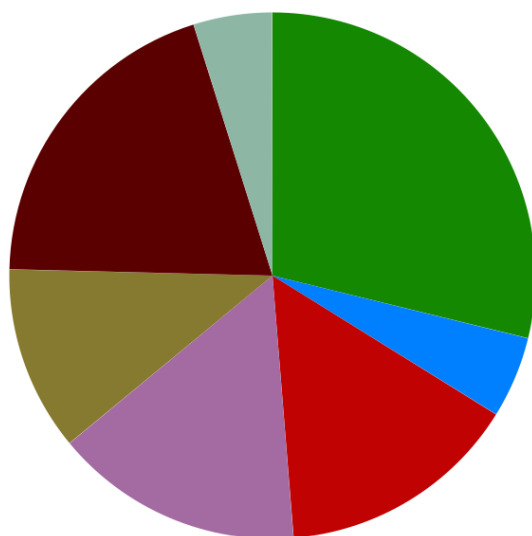

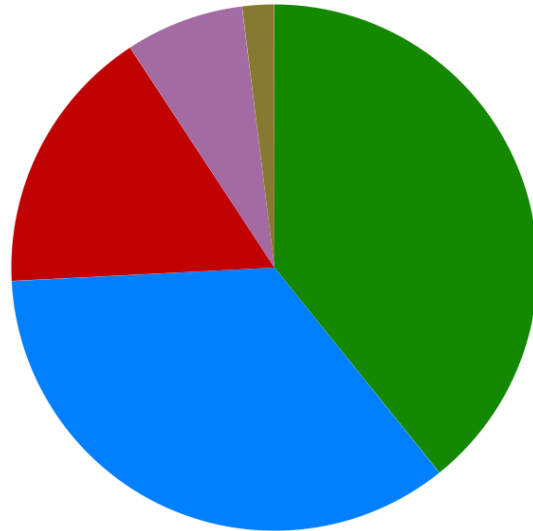

## Health

Ingol has 536 (7.27%) residents in poor health and 145 (1.97%) residents in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 20 (out of 22) within Preston, 657 (out of 935) within North West, and 6,327 (out of 7,707) within England.
